The land breaks down to roughly 90% mature woodland and 10% cleared ground, giving you privacy, timber, and wildlife habitat alongside open space ready for a garden, pasture, or homesite. And speaking of wildlife -- this is whitetail deer and turkey country, with fishing nearby for those who want to spend a weekend on the water instead of behind a desk. If you've been searching for a hunting camp, homestead, or weekend retreat where the outdoors is the main attraction, this tract checks every box. The heavy lifting is already handled: a well and septic system are installed, and a driveway is cut and ready, saving you the time, cost, and headache that usually comes first on raw land. From here, the possibilities are wide open. Because this property is unrestricted, no HOA or zoning committee stands between you and your plans. Bring livestock. Plant a garden. Park a camper or RV. Move in a tiny home or manufactured home. Or start from scratch and design the custom home you've always wanted. This is mini farm living with the freedom to build it your way, on your timeline. With yearly property taxes of just \$310.79, the ongoing cost of ownership is remarkably light for what you're getting -- acreage, a lake view, wildlife, and total flexibility of use. Whether you're looking for a full-time homestead, a part-time hunting retreat, or an investment in unrestricted East Tennessee land near Norris Lake and the Clinch River, this Thorn Hill property is ready to work for you.
